



# Butterfly Smiles - by Jillybean Fitzhenry



Drughes Dynasty Black Gold 206SL - 10/0 script 206A - 1/2" angle 206R - #4 round



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# Instructions

Start with a pink box or basecoat the box with Baby Pink. Transfer the pattern using graphite paper and a stylus or pencil.

#### Brush uses:

Script or liner - use for thin lines, outlines an small details. (Thin the paint with 50% water.) Round - use to fill areas.

Angle - use to float color to shade and highlight.

#### Top Wings

Fill the top edge of the wing with Titanium White. Float Napa Red in the top of the wing, Lavender in the bottom and Desert Turquoise in the center curl. Fill large circles with Cadmium Yellow using a round brush. Fill the small circles with White using the wooden end of the brush. Outline with Navy Blue.

### **Bottom Wings**

Float Bright Green on one side, Desert Turquoise on the other. Fill the tear drop shape with Cadmium Yellow, add a Titanium White dot and outline. Fill the cresent shape with Napa Red. Outline the wing with Navy Blue.

## Body

Float Bright Green on one side and Desert Turquoise on the other. Add Titanium White stripes in the body. Outline, face and antenas are Navy Blue.

#### Border

Float a different color along each of the wavy edges. Corner spirals are each a different color. Wavy line and dots between spirals are Titanium White. Thin lines near edge of design are Titanium White.

#### Finishing

Spray with DecoArt Matte Varnish.
