

NWDA General Meeting

September 11, 2021

Call to Order Time: 10:35 am

Officers Present: Judy Fisher, President; Rose Frank, Financial Secretary, Dawn Cutler, Registration Secretary and Cheryl Smith, Assistant Registration Secretary.

Total Members Present 14.

Judy Fisher welcomed everyone to the meeting. 14 members were present which is a quorum.

Committee Reports

Minutes were discussed and no corrections were identified. Rose Frank moved to accept them as published and Nancy Welch seconded the motion which passed.

Fort Flagler: Mary Ann Campbell reported that we will be having no retreat this year, but hopeful for next year.

Nominating Committee: Nancy Welch, Mary Ann Campbell, and Cheryl Smith. The committee has found some good candidates, but still needs someone for Vice President and Membership Secretary Assistant. Apparently, there was a phone number on the list that did not work. Judy is going to help them with that.

Education Committee: Dawn Cutler, Susan Treiber and Nancy Welch. The Fall Owl workshop is currently half full, but we only need a couple more registrations to break even. Liz Carlson asked that we publish the materials (surface type, surface size and paints) with the initial advertisement to make it easier for people to decide if they can take it or not.

Georgia Magarrell reported that Raindrops are having Linda O'Connell, Jamie Mills Price, and Paulette Di-Gesare next year, and Tugboats are having Sandy LaFlore, Shara Reiner, and Judy Westegard. She would like to coordinate with us on workshops, so we don't have the same teachers in the same year. We have not scheduled any workshops as of yet.
