# Committee Reports

---

## Nominating Committee

### Article VI — Nominations

**Sec. 1....** The nomination of officers shall be made by a Nominating Committee consisting of three (3) active members. Two (2) members shall be elected by the general membership at the July meeting each year. The third member shall be a carry-over member from the prior Nominating Committee, who was selected by the Nominating Committee and approved by the Executive Board. That member would automatically be chairman of the new Nominating Committee.

**Sec. 2....** Nominating Committee members serve for a one (1)-year term except for the carry-over member, who will serve two years. No member shall be eligible for re-election to the Nominating Committee until two (2) years shall have elapsed after their service.

**Sec. 3....** The Nominating Committee shall obtain the consent of each candidate for office before the name is placed in nomination. All nominees for office must be members in good standing in Northwest Decorative Artists for the preceding two (2) years. The Vice President must have prior Board experience with an SDP Chapter. Board nominees may not be on the board of another chapter for the year to be served. A member of the Nominating Committee may become a candidate for office without resigning from the Committee. Each nominee should receive two (2) copies of the duties of the position. To accept their nomination, they must sign and return one copy to the Nominating Committee. These should be attached to the committee report. The Nominating Committee's report will be submitted to the Board prior to their meeting preceding the election meeting.

**Sec. 4....** A résumé of each nominated officer shall appear in the newsletter prior to the November meeting.

**Sec. 5....** The Nominating Committee shall report at the November meeting and will submit the name of one (1) or more candidate(s) for each of the following offices to be filled:

- a) President (automatic; Vice President previous year)
- b) Vice President
- c) Secretary
- d) Treasurer
- e) Financial Secretary
- f) Membership Secretary
- g) Membership Secretary Assistant

Nominations for officers will also be solicited from the membership on election day.

**Sec. 6....** The Nominating Committee shall be responsible for providing voting materials and for the collection and counting of ballots in the event of more than one nominee in any one position.

**Sec. 7....** In the absence of an immediate Past-President, the Nominating Committee Chairman will be responsible for recognition of the outgoing officers and installation of new officers.

It is time for us to plan for our next change in leadership. Please be thinking about if you would like to be on the nominating committee for 2022 or if you are interested in being an officer on our Executive Board.

Nancy Welch and Rose Frank , you were the nominating committee in 2019 and one of you will need to be the carryover.
