Treasure Boxes—Joy Halladay

Our service project for 2022 is to paint treasure boxes for the children at Shriner's Children's Hospital in Spokane, WA.

Shriners treats children up to the age of 18 from Washington, Idaho, Montana, Alaska, and Canada as well as globally, with Spine and Spinal Cord Injuries, Cerebral Palsy, Clubfoot, and other serious mobility issues. They perform approximately 1000 surgeries per year.

Boxes: Our treasure boxes are painted on document or photo boxes, purchased from craft stores. Size is approximately Size: 11.2" x 7.8" x 4.5".



Get reimbursed for the boxes: You can get reimbursed for the boxes by emailing a Reimbursement Request Form with your receipt to Monica at mbayness@gmail.com. The Reimbursement Form is located on our website in the "Members Only" Section (password NW22DA).

Patterns: We have children's patterns available located on our website under the "Links Tab." Look for the turtle with the balloons. You can also use your own pattern, but we ask that you not use commercialized designs such as Disney, etc.

Finishing: The boxes must be varnished. Spray varnishing works the best, since they are made of paper. Please keep painting these wonderful treasure boxes. They are greatly appreciated!

JEAN SHOEMAKER – JUNE 2, 1936–MAY 6, 2022



Jean Marie (Brookbank) Shoemaker was born June 2, 1936 in Appleton, Wisconsin and she died in Coupeville, Washington on May 6, 2022. She grew up in Chillicothe, Ohio and after high school graduation in 1954, she came to Seattle to attend the University of Washington, where she earned her Bachelor of Science degree in Home Economics in 1968. It was at the University of Washington, where Jean met her future husband, Bob Shoemaker, whom she married in 1956. Bob & Jean were long-term residents of Edmonds, where Jean worked in the Edmonds School District as a substitute teacher, while she raised her family.

Jean is survived by her four children (Robert, Christina, Fritz, and Deborah), by five grandchildren and two great-grandchildren. She is also survived by a sister and a brother. Her husband, Bob, preceded her in death.

She enjoyed golfing as an outdoor activity, but she enjoyed decorative painting as an indoor activity. At some point in the 1980's, she became aware of the painting when she attended a convention with a friend which fueled this activity. She joined the Society of Decorative Painters and the Northwest Decorative Artists, aka Northwest Toileliners, during that time. She volunteered much time to both of these groups.

She attended SDP conventions, Northwest Regional conventions, and many Las Vegas conventions. She devoted time when she would be at an SDP convention to help as a monitor in classes, but particularly, many times, volunteered as a Teller at the Annual Meeting. For her chapter, she served as a board and committee member many times and as President in 1989. For regional conventions, she volunteered in various capacities.

Over the years, Jean also did a lot of travel, much of it to Europe, where she was able to focus on the folk art of many different countries. She loved taking classes, particularly with JoSonja and many, many others.

Jean was a prime example of what the member of a membership organization should be. She contributed in many ways to help the group in their activities.

Old Business:

Education – Dawn Cutler reported that we have 13 signed up for the Nancy Scott convention and are close to covering the costs. The Lynne Andrews class will be opened later this summer. Discussion on why we didn't open up registration early brought up by Monica.

Financial report by Monica Bayness– Motion by Nancy Welch to approve financial report in newsletter. Diane Caldwell seconded; motion approved. Judy Fisher asked if all the banking was now at Key Bank, she has set up storage unit payment with Key Bank. Monica responded that we still have an account at Sound Credit Union.

Membership – MaryAnn Campbell reported no new members, and our total is currently 43 members

Newsletter – Nancy Welch reported all newsletters were being emailed except for 3 due to computer/internet issues. Deadline for next newsletter will be June 19th.

Paint In's workshop – Monica Bayness reported we have Kim Falk teaching in July, Holly McDonald in September and Judy Fischer and MaryAnn Campbell teaching in November. She is looking for teachers for next year, that to contact her if interested.

Fort Flagler – Mary Ann Campbell reported they are still closed except for tent camping. She will keep checking but it's unsure for this year.

Treasure Boxes – Joy Halladay updated us on boxes. Michael's prices are around \$6 but Hobby Lobby has them for about \$3. The chapter will reimburse the cost, just send a receipt to Monica Bayness. Discussion over who was keeping track of the old boxes that had been purchased for the chapter, those have all been painted. Nancy Welch mentioned SDP wants to put an article about our boxes in the next newsletter with pictures. Discussion over what ones would be appropriate for a publication, no copyright infringement. Mary Ellerman brought up the purpose of the boxes, that they are for the children in the Shriners Hospital. She has been told several patients are being treated in the burn unit and that most are from Mexico. That they really appreciate the boxes, and it is a valued service. Also, it was discussed that the painter and artist

Group voted to skip it this year and future interest still needs to be discussed. Ideas for advertising are needed for alternatives, Georgia mentioned SDP Chapter Gathering group on Facebook. Holiday Bazaar update, Joy Halladay – a discussion within the group was held if this was something the chapter wants to do this year or in the future. The board had discussed changing the platform from a fundraiser to a donating project MaryAnn Campbell mentioned making cards and decorative items for nursing homes and she has already contacted one that is interested. Rose Frank made a motion for a vote but after much discussion retracted it. Susan Treiber pointed out that fundraising and service projects and two different types of committees, so one would not replace the other. Regarding the holiday bazaar, this is something that would need a vote from the chapter. We discussed sending out a survey first using Monkey Survey.
