Old Business:

Meeting Opened: 10:08 AM

Quorum: We have a quorum.

November 2022 General Meeting Minutes: Motion to accept minutes as published in the newsletter: Mary Ellerman asked that we add who motioned and seconded the approved new board members. Karla Linder, MaryAnn Campbell seconded, minutes were approved as corrected.

Installation of New Officers: Susan thanked the officers who served in 2022 and mentioned MaryAnn Campbell and Diane Caldwell were stepping down. The new board was welcomed and introduced.

Treasurer report - Monica went over the report that was put in the newsletter. There was a transfer of \$582.27 from savings to balance the accounts. The projection for 2022 was \$2000 but with our revenue from membership and seminars we did not need that whole amount. Motion to approve minutes: Mary Ellerman made motion with Joy Halladay seconded it, motion passed.

The 2023 budget was discussed, and any changes needed. Motion made by MaryAnn Campbell, Judy seconded it, motion passed.

Education chair report – Dawn reported 42 registrations for Paulette DeGisare "Christmas Sampler" workshop, 15 are new members. "Kringel" with Maxine Thomas in March has 28 registered, with 7 new members. We also have Lynne Andrews in July (project TDB) and Prudy Vannier "Santa Spindles" in September.

Membership – Karla reported we have 36 new members and as of today we have 70 members' total. Of the 70 we have 35 returning and 9 have not been renewed yet.

Newsletter – Susan Treiber has been filling in for Nancy Welch who is back and will be doing the newsletter. Please have any newsletter info to Nancy by February 18th.

Birthday Cards - Judy asked for the birthday list to be put on the website.

Paint In's – Monica Bayness had the 5 paint ins planned for 2023 and pictures are on the website. Today's project is treasure boxes but the next one will be "Funky Chickens" with Barb Brady.

Treasure Boxes – Joy reported that 29 boxes were sent to Shriner's. Barb Pearson asked if her group of high school students could paint some boxes. Discussion over what boxes and designs worked as well as how to get reimbursed for the supplies.

Sunshine – Rose reported that she sent a card to Sue Calvin and Janie Sevela.

SDP - they have officially merged with their foundation and that releases the chapters. A confidential vote was done with the NWDA to form an independent group or dissolve. 2/3 of the members voted and it was unanimous to continue as an independent group. Susan and Kim are working with the lawyer (Lyda Lawfirm, Bothell, WA) to get things started.

Bylaws and Standing Rules revision: Susan updated the bylaws and standing rules by taking out all the SDP and chapter references. Mary pointed out some typo errors that will be fixed. The attorney will need to fix the bylaws and standing rules to comply with Washington State so they will be changed as needed. Motion to accept the changes as of now made by MaryAnn Campbell and seconded by Joy Halladay, motion passed.

A concern was voiced about membership no longer having different fees for teachers and businesses. Susan said, this was part of the strategic plan and was voted on by the membership. She is going to check on the specifics.

### **New Business:**

Open Zoom room - February 26th @ 1:00 PM. We will have a few hours to chat and paint whatever project you are working on. If it goes well, we will open more in the future.

Spin the wheel raffle – Rochelle Duprey won, picked the Kringle workshop as the prize.

Show and tell – Judy, Cheryl, Joy, Dawn and Rose showed projects.

Meeting Adjournment: motion made by Mary Ellerman, seconded by Judy Fisher.

The meeting ended at 11:42.

# Funky Chickens

### Funky Chickens Prep

### Adapted from picture in Pinterest

### **DecoArt Americana Paints**

Antique White Country Red Slate Grey
Black Hauser Light Sunny Day
Black Plum Hauser Medium Warm White

Burnt SiennaMarigoldZincButtermilkMelonSand GrayCobblestoneMorning MistGolden Straw

Cocoa Plantation Pine

### **Supplies:**

Surface of your Choice. This can be done on a wood surface, a plate, a canvas, a teapot. Use your imagination. Stencil of your choice (Buffalo plaid, checks, chicken wire, polka dots etc.)

I used a buffalo stencil from Tim Holtz.

Your favorite brushes

White Gel Pen

Identipen

**Regular Painting supplies** 

### **Background Preparation:**

Paint entire surface with background color of your choice. Measure off pattern area and base in slate Gray. Stencil the nonpattern area with the stencil you chose (ie: buffalo plaid, checks, etc.). If you wish to stencil background of the pattern area do so now (ie: chicken wire) in the color of your choice.

After dry put on pattern.

### Chicken:

Top off body is Warm White. Bottom of body is Black. The cheeks, waddle and plume are Country Red. Eyes are Warm White. Beak is Marigold.

Tail feathers are numbered on patten and based as follows: 2, 8, 12, 15, Black.

1, 3, 5, 9, 14, 13 Cobblestone.

4, 7, 10, 11 Zinc.

6 Moring Mist

Eggs are based in Antique White.

### Funky Chickens

# Adapted from picture in Pinterest Finishing instructions

Chicken: top of body is lightly shaded with Black. Use your stylist to apply black dots. I used two different sizes.

Bottom of chicken body has several different sizes of dots in cobblestone. Use different sizes of stylists the end of a brush, stencil or anything that will give you the desired size dots.

The cheeks, waddle and plume are shaded with Black Plum and highlighted with Melon.

The eyes have a black dot in the middle.

The beak is shaded with burnt sienna and highlighted with Sunny Day.

### Tailfeathers pattern:

Feathers 1, 3, 5, 9, and 13 are lined with Warm White.

2, 8, 12 and 15 are a plaid with Morning Mist.

4, 7, 10, and 11 are dots of cobblestone.

6 and 14 have black dots.

After the patterns are applied to tailfeathers all are shaded with black.


Eggs are shaded with cocoa and drybrush centers with buttermilk.

Grass is applied to the ground area using your liner and a combination of Golden Straw, Hauser Light, Hauser Medium, Plantation Pine, and Burnt Sienna.

Using your Identipen outline the entire pattern. Also, with the Identipen apply the dotted lines on upper white half of chicken body. The black lower half of the body has white dotted lines using the white gel pen.

Finish by varnishing or using a spray finish.
